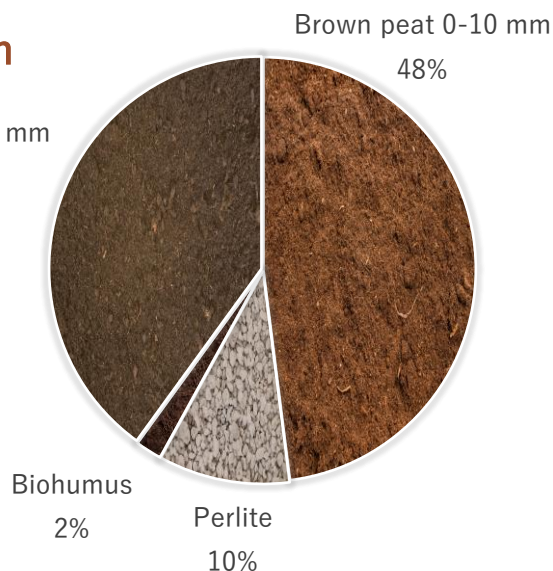

**Usage** This soil is designed for growing herbs such as basil, parsley, dill, oregano, coriander, thyme, etc.; microgreens such as sunflower, radish, pea, etc.; and medicinal plants such as mint, lemon balm, chamomile, sage, etc.. It is suitable for use in pots, trays, cell packs, containers, or raised beds. The substrate is made from light and dark sphagnum peat, enriched with Biohumus, perlite, and zeolite. The mixture ensures a balanced ratio of air, water, and nutrients, supporting uniform germination, strong root development, and vigorous plant growth.

**Warranty** Substrate is free of hazardous materials, micro-organisms and fungi which can harm plants; free of GMO, hormones, salmonella, brucella, weed seeds, nematodes.
